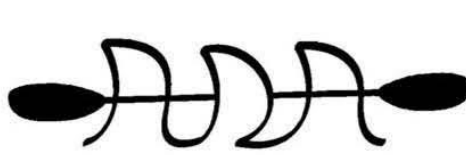

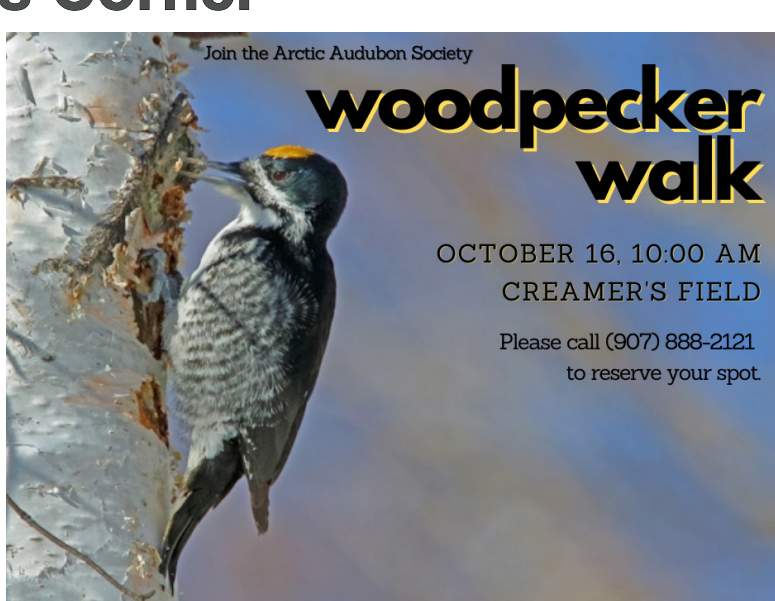
Creamer's Corner
