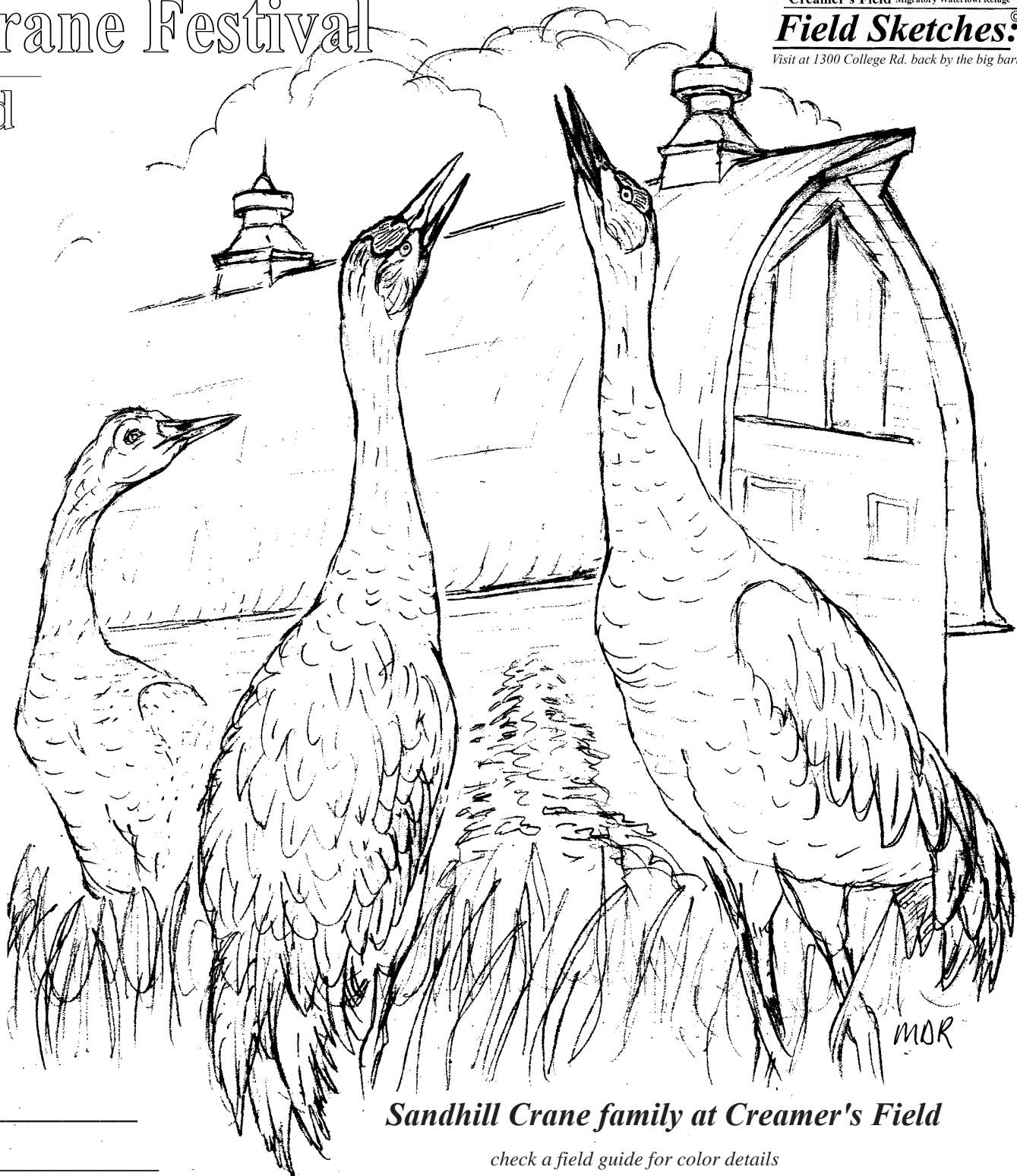

About the Cranes:

By the end of August thousands of Sandhill Cranes gather in the fields. Listen and look carefully to pick out the adults and their young. Adults are grayer with some brown. Young have chestnut plumage, nearly orange. Their eyes are brown rather than orange like the adults. Adults have a red skin cap; young have a brown feathered cap. The voice of the young is a quiet peeping trill. Creamer's Field is a gathering area for cranes in preparation for migration to Texas and other areas of the southwest lower-48 and northern Mexico.
